Learning Modules

■ Core English Classes

Upon arrival, students undergo speaking and written English assessments to determine their proficiency. They are then placed in small, tailored classes to ensure a personalised learning experience that maximise individual progress.

■ British History and Culture

Eton brings history to life. For example, students will explore the history of Hampton Court through multimedia such as videos, pictures, and songs before visiting the site and experiencing history firsthand.

■ Elite Alumni Lectures

Eton alumni experts lead sessions on topics like music, leadership, sports, and creativity. These inspiring lectures provide unique insights into Eton's legacy, broadening students' perspectives and fostering future aspirations.

■ Speech, Communication, and Leadership

This module develops essential skills such as creative thinking, resilience, communication, public speaking, and teamwork. It is designed to unlock potential and nurture key leadership qualities.

■ Debating and Oxbridge Admissions Seminar

Through two themed debates and an exclusive Oxbridge University admissions Q&A session, students will discuss academic hot topics in English, sparking ideas and exchanging views with peers.

■ Sports Competitions

The summer school organizes various traditional British sports competitions in groups. Students will also compete at the Dorney Lake Rowing Centre, a facility owned by Eton College and the venue for the 2012 London Olympic rowing events.
