Founded by Dame Frances Dove, one of the first women to attend the University of Cambridge, Wycombe Abbey excels in fostering academic brilliance while nurturing creativity, physical prowess, and social skills within a supportive and fulfilling community.

Excellence in Sports and Arts

Wycombe Abbey offers exceptional sports and arts facilities, including five hockey fields, indoor and outdoor basketball courts, 20 tennis courts, and numerous multi-purpose sports fields. The school also features dance studios, fitness suites, fencing strips, climbing walls, a 200-seat auditorium, and the Lancaster Arts Centre with 30 music practice rooms. A third of its students receive offers from Oxford and Cambridge, with many others securing places at top Russell Group universities and renowned art and drama colleges.

Learning Modules

English Core Curriculum

The Wycombe Abbey Summer School offers an exceptional opportunity for students to interact with peers from around the world, immersing themselves in British culture while enhancing their English proficiency. The programme includes three core courses:

British Culture

In these lessons, students learn about important parts of British history, society and culture. Students will better understand a range of aspects of British culture, including fashion, music, accents, films, literature and history. These lessons will also teach them key information about the cities and museums they will visit during their excursions, so that they can get more out of the experience.

English for Academic Purposes & Exams

These lessons focus on improving students' core English skills while helping them understand how best to answer exam questions. Each lesson focuses on a particular part of an English exam, with students improving their listening, writing, speaking and grammar in a more engaging way. Each week ends with a mock IELTS exam for students to assess their progress over the course.

21st Century Skills

These lessons allow students to improve their English while also developing the key skills needed to succeed in the modern world. Students learn about a range of topics including presentation design and delivery, digital technology, leadership and teamwork. Lessons use a project-based learning approach with an element of STEM learning that allows students to work collaboratively and creatively.



Electives

All students have 2 hours of elective courses in the afternoons. They can choose one from these four choices:

Leadership & Sustainability

In this elective, students will learn how to be an effective and sustainable leader in the modern world. Students will discover important concepts ranging from public speaking, leading a team and designing a product to creating a brand identity and understanding how to develop sustainable alternatives to existing methods and products.

Coding & Game Design

During this elective, students will be introduced to the fundamentals of computer programming as they learn how to code using Python as well as how to create their own computer game. Students will create different kinds of games, harnessing their creativity and design skills as they bring their ideas to life. As well as this, students will use Lego Robotics to build their own robots and then code them to perform different functions.

Performing Arts

The Performing Arts elective takes students on a journey through the production of a play. Students learn about stage direction, blocking and the history of theatre as well as rehearsing scenes from popular plays and

musicals as they improve their confidence, stage presence and theatrical skills. Students will also create and develop their own performance from writing it to rehearsing and eventually performing it. Students will be led by an experienced drama teacher and will be given the chance to try different genres of theatre as they look more closely at what makes a good play, how to project their voice, how to engage an audience and many other skills that will not only enhance their dramatic ability, but also their overall English and leadership skills.

Sports, Health & Wellbeing

In the Sports, Health & Wellbeing elective, students will learn the importance of nutrition and mental wellbeing, while also looking into the data behind sport science as they delve into a range of different sports and exercises that will enable them to develop a healthier lifestyle. Alongside learning in the classroom, students will also engage in an array of different sports outside. Utilising the incredible resources available at Wycombe Abbey, students will be granted the chance to try new sports and improve their skills in sports they are familiar with putting their new found knowledge to practice.
