Learning Modules

■ English Language and Literature

Delve into Rudyard Kipling's "Just So" stories to open the door to the imaginative world of literature for young learners. This is linked with a visit to Wisley Gardens and Marwell Zoo bringing students close to nature, inspiring writing, and cultivating observation and writing skills to lay a solid foundation for English literary creation.

■ Nature and Science

Science classes at Charterhouse offer students the chance to study the local flora, including plants, trees, and flowers, through hands-on outdoor activities and classroom sessions. By observing nature firsthand, students bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical experience, gaining a unique and immersive understanding of the scientific world.

■ Geography and Humanities

Embark on a virtual exploration of the three countries that make up Great Britain. Students will explore its diverse cities and landscapes, gaining insight into the UK's rich geography. This approach not only expands students' geographical knowledge but also sparks curiosity about the Earth's diverse natural environments.

■ History and Development

Dive into the history of the Norman Conquest of 1066 and the development of castles during this pivotal period. Students will also explore the rich history of Charterhouse itself, fostering a deeper appreciation for cultural heritage and historical progress.

■ Overview of Britain
